# **ADMISSIONS**

#### Eligiblity for admission - Pre KG

A child should have completed 2 years and six months by the end of April for admission to Pre KG and proportionately for higher classes. Parents must ensure that the correct spelling and Date of Birth is entered in the application form. The fees should be remitted within the date scheduled. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

#### Admission is based on the performance in the entrance test.

II Language - Tamil

**I Std onwards** - Written test in English, Math and Tamil.

Results of the Entrance test will be published on the Notice Board within 3 days from the date of test.

The classes will commence from the reopening day in June.

After admission, the student and the Parents / Guardian are expected to abide by the rules and regulations of the school.

#### **WITHDRAWALS**

## **OPEN HOUSE**

# FACILITIES PAR EXCELLENCE

#### **MATH LAB**

Math lab aims at making the subject interesting to learn and easy to comprehend. It enhances the mathematical aptitude, logical thinking, reasoning and problem solving ability in each child.

## **ENGLISH LAB**

Enables children to develop communicative and soft skills. It helps children learn correct communication, oral and written expression.

#### **SCIENCE LAB**

## **E-LEARNING**

A fully air – conditioned Computer Center is available with multimedia and Internet facility, continuously being upgraded keeping pace with the technical development in the field.

#### **ROBOTICS**

## **LIBRARY**

# **INSTRUCTION TO STUDENTS**

- 1. Bring the handbook to school everyday.
- 2. Read the handbook carefully and abide by the norms furnished.
- 3. "Prayer is the Soul's sincere desire". Hence participate and attend the prayer and other devotional Bhajans conducted in the school, sincerely to improve a good state of mind and to possess a balanced temperament.
- 4. Students shall display courtesy, good manners and proper form of respect to all teachers and other school authorities regardless of their designations / positions.
- 5. Be punctual to school by being present on the premises 5 minutes prior to the prayer bell. Habitual late comers are liable for severe punishment.
- 6. It is a must to come to school in full uniform. Girls must have two plaits with Black ribbons. Fancy clips and hair bands are not allowed. Keep your nails clean and closely clipped. Boys must have short and neat hair cut. Dyeing of hair is strictly prohibited
- 7. Mobile Phones are strictly **Banned**.
- 8. The school will not take up the responsibility of any valuable article if lost by the child.
- 9. As a safety measure the students are advised not to wear any gold jewellery.
- 10. It is a must to converse in English within the school premises.
- 11. Silence and disciplined behaviour must be observed wherever needed and whenever they are asked to do so.
- 12. Students are strictly warned against entering the laboratory and library without the presence of their respective teachers.
- 13. Students should not enter the office, Staff Room and the Principal's room without permission.
- 14. Success comes to those who persevere in their attempts. So make consistent efforts to study well and attend all exams without fail.
- 15. Scribbling on the walls, damaging the school property is strictly forbidden.
- 16. Students should not leave the school premises during the class hours or lunch or at the interval times. Under essential and unavoidable circumstances, obtaining necessary permission from the class teacher / Principal is a must.
- 17. "A Sound mind in a Sound Body". To maintain good health students are advised not to buy eatables from the roadside hawkers near the school.
- 18. Students suffering from any infectious or contagious diseases are strictly forbidden against attending their regular classes till the quarantine period is over. They have to produce a fitness certificate from a qualified doctor.
- 19. Healthy and Hygienic food is available in the School Canteen during the short break 10.00 -10.15 a.m., LUNCH BREAK and at 3.00 p.m.
